THE 4 BEASTS OF DANIEL 7 & 8

This prophecy was given in the 6th Century BC, before the events mentioned came to be.

1st beast was a lion with two wings which represented Nebuchadnezzar and Babylon. The roots of Babylon's power goes back to Genesis 10 where Nimrod was building Babylon, which was the site for the tower of Babel. This spirit of defiance and rebellion against God had been transferred on to the Babylon of Daniel's day. This power is transferred from one beast to another until it reaches the "little horn" of the 4th beast which is the Anti-Christ in Revelation 12/13.

2nd beast, the lopsided bear (Ram with two unequal horns in Dan. 8) represents the Medo-Persian Empire where Persia was more powerful than the Medes.

3rd beast, the leopard with two sets of wings (the goat in Dan. 8) represents Greece. Alexander the great is the little horn between the eyes. Four horns that arose represent Alexander's four Generals who split up his empire after his dead because he did not have an heir. The little horn that appeared from these 4 horns is believed to be Antiochus IV Epiphanes who terrorised the Jews from 174-165 BC.

 4^{th} beast is the most terrifying of all. Revelation 12 and 13 sees it as a combination of all previous beasts. Ten horns arose from this beast, and out of the ten horns a "little horn" appears that blasphemes God's name and wars with the saints. This 4^{th} beast represents the Roman Empire, and the ten provinces/kings that the empire had.

John in Revelation picks up this vision and projects it to the future. The Anti-Christ (also "ante" in Greek, which means both "against" or a "substitute" for Christ) will receive its power from the ten horns to rule and war against the saints. This situation where ten kings/governments will come together to empower one person to control a one-world economy, politics and religion is yet to happen in world history.

Some takeaway points:

- (1) God controls history. Events in history do not happen randomly. The Bible teaches that there are spiritual forces propelling the events in one particular direction.
- (2) The animal nature in us. The 1st century readers were not waiting for actual animals to show up and rule them. But they know what it is like to live under a government that behaves like a cruel animal. And we can expect more of this animal nature in governments to increase in the Last Days. But whereas the worldly Empires are represented by predatory animals, God reveals Himself as a helpless Lamb who takes away the sins of the world.
- (3) The concept of time. All the days of the worldly empires are numbered (2300 days, times-times and a half). But God's kingdom is forever and ever. If we look at Christianity or the church from the perspective of Babylon's glory, it looks weak and dying. But to use a Chesterton analogy of the Dark-ages, the ship that sank turned into a submarine and re-emerged a mighty ship.
- (4) Worship of a man. Revelation says 666 is the number of a man, whom the world will one day worship. This is possible, as we know how easy it is to slide from admiration to worship of an important man; or even slide from hate to worship of a powerful man.
- (5) The copy-cat criminal. All that the Devil can do is to imitate God. And he will lead many astray. The only way to be safe from this powerful deception is to be firmly rooted in the Bible
- (6) Horn of salvation. Daniel 8 announces the horn of destruction. Luke 1 announces the coming of the "Horn of Salvation", that is Jesus Christ. Pastor Kedo Pesevie
