

## I Corinthians 15: 3-8, 50-58

For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance : that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,

and that He appeared to Peter, and then to the Twelve.

After that, He appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep.

Then He appeared to James, then to all the apostles, and last of all He appeared to me also, as to one abnormally born.

I declare to you, brothers, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed

in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.

For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality.

When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true: "Death has been swallowed up in victory."

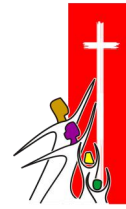
"Where, O death, is your victory?
