The Writing on the Wall

(Daniel 5)

The Babylonian era is about to end within 24 hours time, and the Medo-Persian era will begin. Daniel 5 is within this 24 hours bracket. This is not an unlikely scene because we learn that the Medo-Persian army had encamped around the gates and walls of Babylon as Belshazzar feasted with his lords. Babylonian exile and rule was a time of "Pagan *domination* and rule over Israel". The Medo-Persian Empire brought in an era of *restoration* by allowing the Jews to return to Jerusalem and build the Temple.

Who was Belshazzar? After Nebuchadnezzar, his son Nabonidus (the last king of Babylon) took over. Belshazzar is the son of Nabonidus. Nabonidus was away for 10 years fighting in Arabia, and during that time he put his son Belshazzar second-in-charge of his kingdom. Daniel was offered the "third" ruler position. Belshazzar had no character or discipline of a king. The only way he can impress his kingdom is by throwing a big party. And this feast led to his downfall.

Lessons to learn:

(1) Belshazzar was a self-centred man. CS Lewis says that selfishness is not always bad and is often useful, but thorough self-centeredness is never good. It is pure evil because everything has to revolve around the "I". When self-centredness grows, judgement is swift (as in Belshazzar's case).

(2) Holy-Common-Sinful. Belshazzar takes the temple utensils (1:2, 5:2) and uses them to drink and praise his idols. He had taken a holy thing, made it common and sinful. This movement from "Holy" to "sinful" happens all the time. For example, we can turn our calling into politics (which is holy), into a common one by becoming like everyone else in the profession, and turn it into sin by abusing power and trust of people. If this happens, judgement is not far away.

(3) God will hold us responsible for the knowledge we have. v. 22, "...and you his son, have not humbled your heart, though you knew all these ... " Romans 1 say that everything we need to know about God has been revealed. The question is whether are as acting and living on what we know.

MENE, MENE, TEKEL, PARSIN (Numbered. Numbered. Weighed. Divided).

Mene, Mene: your days are numbered. Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain a heart of wisdom (Ps 90:12).

Tekel: you are weighed and found wanting. This is not a scale where we have our bad deeds on one side and our good deeds on the other to balance out our good and bad. But imagine you on one side, and God's Divine Law on the other side. On your own you weigh nothing, and God's law is heavy. But if Christ puts his blood and righteousness on you, that balances out the scales.

Parsin: If you do not believe in Jesus, you will be weighed and found wanting, and then you will be divided and thrown over into Hell.

Finger of God. The "finger of God" appears in other parts of the Bible: The Law given through Moses was written on stone with the finger of God (Exodus 31:18). "When I look at ... the work of your fingers" Psalm 8. Jesus writes on the ground with his finger as the Pharisees shouted condemning a woman (John 8).

The fingers of God will write again soon. What will it say? Learn to number your days aright and live in the fear of God. Let Christ and His work on the Cross fill your side of the scale. Then you will be safe and secure. - Pastor Kedo Pesevie
