Last Sunday message....

TRUE FAITH (James 2:14-26 / 3:13-18.)

Faith comes from God. But there is also counterfeit faith. The Devil thrives only on counterfeits. He is the master of deception and lies.

The Counterfeits:

(1) Mere confessional faith. This is a faith that ends with mere words. We say we are Christians and we write them in our application forms and documents. But are we? We make big claims and high promises to ourselves and people, but do we even have the power and will to fulfil them? (2) Mere intellectual faith. Knowing doctrine and theology does not necessarily lead to true faith. Os Guinness says that most intellectuals today are guilty of changing truth to fit present realities, rather than conforming realities to truth (Os Guinness, "Fool's Talk"). If this is true, intellectuals are the most dangerous people on earth. The thrill of intellectual engagements can mimic the excitement of true faith. Our emotions can be created and controlled by different forces like colours, light, darkness, words, praise, etc. Demons also react emotionally to God, but they still reject God.

Is true faith less than the above considerations? No. It includes our confession of Jesus as the Son of God; it includes the transforming of our minds by the entire Word of God; it includes emotional well-being and experiences of glory. But it is much more.

True Faith

(1) True Faith is *from God*. Faith is a gift from God. Ephe. 2:8-9. Gal.2:16, 20. 2Tim. 1:5 (KJV). These verses in the KJV make it clear that faith is a gift from God. It is not "*my*" faith or "*your*" faith that saves us, but it is the faith *of* Christ that comes upon us when we believe and put our whole trust in Jesus.

How does this faith come? It comes when we are exposed to the Word of God. Or to be more specific, when we expose others to the Gospel - that Jesus died, was buried and rose again. No one can create this faith. But we can all expose ourselves and others to the Word of God. When the Word of God is honoured, the Holy Spirit gets activated.

(2) True Faith is Saving-Faith. This faith saves because it comes from God. This is the faith that Jesus exercised upon the Cross.

(3) True faith is Dynamic Faith. This is a faith that becomes active in good works. James is not asking us to add good works to our faith. James is saying if we have true faith, it will result in good works.

The different metaphors James uses are useful. Think of a seed. A seed has life, power and beauty of its own. We only nurture and allow it to grow. Or think of a stream. Can a salt water stream produce fresh water? In both cases, James takes us back to the real source of everything – faith that comes from God. If we don't have this faith, no amount of effort and hard work can produce the life, beauty and power that come from God alone. *Christianity requires hard work and discipline, but this hard-work should not be directed toward trying to produce our own righteousness, but we should direct all our energy toward nurturing and making the seed grow, or allowing the fresh water stream to flow from its natural source.*

(4) Counterfeit faith works itself towards demonic wisdom (James 3: 15). True faith results in Godly wisdom. It is up to us which wisdom we want to have.

(5) We have the faith of Christ within us. If this is true (and it is), this means that God has already given us everything we need to live full and abundant lives on earth. We should not be wasting our life waiting to receive more from God. God has already supplied. Now all that remain is for us to realise, actualise and release the power of faith God has deposited within us. - Pastor Kedo Pesevie
