Last Sunday Message... WE DO NOT LOSE HEART... Continued.

(1) We are being renewed day by day, v.16.

- Paul does not say he is renewing himself, but being renewed by God.
- We simply have to place ourselves in a position or a place where God can renew us daily. Some people call this place "The Quiet Time".
- Illustration: A young boy went to a big football game with his father. He gets lost in the crowd, but immediately remembers that his father told him to wait at the popcorn stall if he gets lost. He was found later by his father because he placed himself in a place where he could be found.
- We often overfeed our outer man and forget the inner man. But the inner man needs daily renewal by the one who made it. This is the only way our faith and resilience can grow.
- Someone said the only way to live the Christian life is "everyday".
- (2) God is our Shield (v.17). We can understand this in the following ways:
- The shield is the one that takes all the blows that were meant for us. Jesus took the wrath of God for us on the Cross.
- God shields us from all the problems and suffering around us.
- The problems and pain that we are presently going through are actually shielding us from something worse that could happen to us. When we go through pain, it is difficult to imagine what could be worse than that. But it could be that God is allowing our outer man to suffer so that our inner man can be preserved for eternity.
- Our present pain and suffering are preparing for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. The Shield is actually like a machine that is turning the arrows of the enemy into something advantageous for us.

(3) Fix your eyes on Jesus (v.18).

- Look Back: Fix your eyes on the Cross. Jesus finished everything for us. We need to learn to live in the promise of the Cross—forgiven, accepted and loved beyond measure.
- Look to the Present: Fix your eyes on the Resurrection of Jesus. The power that raised Jesus from the dead is the same power that works in us. This will help us overcome our present sufferings.
- Look Ahead: Fix your eyes on the Second coming of Jesus. Jesus will return to restore all things, renew and reward us, and take us into His eternal Kingdom. The night will not run over into the Day. The Day will conquer all evil. This is our Hope.
