"Christian church" and Christian fellowship is heaven on earth.

Christian fellowship is: (1) Grounded on God's Word and on God "The Trinity" Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. In love relationship. (2) It is mutual. The unity of believers in fellowship as Jesus prayed in Jn17:20-23. (3) It is renewed and empowered daily and progressively by God's Spirit.

It is not compartmental (e.g., spiritual gathering only on Sunday fellowship and disappear and forget each other on other week days). But it involves spiritual and social through a living relationship with Christ Himself.

<u>The Reality of the Resurrection.</u> (1 Corinthians 15:3-11, 50-58) (Easter Sunday Morning 16th April) - **Kedo Peseyie**

When we examine all the historical evidences of the resurrection of Jesus, it becomes hard not to believe in it, because there is rock solid evidence. Every page in the New Testament talks about the resurrection. The New Testament was written, distributed, tested and approved while all the witnesses of Jesus' life and resurrection (and the empty tomb) were still alive. Paul challenges his readers to go and verify for themselves. He offers them more than 500 witnesses, including some respectable and reliable leaders of the day.

Because of the resurrection, (1) Life is worth living, and there is work to do. (2) Prayer is meaningful because we pray "in His living name". (3) We have a new future that is not a product of our past memories, but it comes straight from God's eternity. (4) We can handle death with confidence because it only makes us stronger-what we can swallow makes us stronger. (5) Evangelism and the Great Commission is more urgent. (6) Out eternity is secure.

The Power of the Resurrection. (Philippians 3) (Easter Sunday Evening_16th April)

PASSION WEEK SERMON GIST

Is Jesus God? (John 10:30-33) (Wednesday_12th April)

Look at the beauty, wonder and vastness of creation, the billions of galaxies and the billions and billions of stars. God created them and calls them out by name (Isaiah 40:25-26). What if we can know this God personally? What if this great God wants to come into your life? The New Testament claims that this great God incarnated in Jesus Christ and came seeking the ones that He created in His own image. The New Testament is a historically reliable document and every page of it claims that Jesus is God. Jesus Himself claims to be God and proves it by His miracles and by the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies, and finally by His death and resurrection. Anyone who makes the claims Jesus makes cannot be just a nice-humble-moral-teacher. He is either who He says He is, or He is a mere lunatic. Make your choice.

Why Did Jesus Die? (Thursday Evening_13th April).

Man disobeyed and sinned against God. The consequence of which is death (Spiritual deatheternal separation from God). But God loves us that He provided the perfect solution- His only Son as a sacrifice of atonement. Jesus had to die on the cross because

- He is the perfect lamb of God and our death is not sufficient to atone for sin of humans (1 Peter 1:18-19)
- His death satisfies the wrath of God. God's just wrath is turned from sinners. Penalty of sin did not have to be paid by the sinners. (2 Cor. 5:21; Romans 3:24,25)
- His death restored relationship between God and human which was broken. Because sin has separated us from God (Isaiah 59:2).

Now, In Christ – Sinners are saved (I Tim 1:15) and Justified (Romans 3:26)

The Meaning of the Cross. (1 Peter 2:24-25) (Good Friday_14th April)

- (1) Forgiveness is costly suffering. "Sorry" does not wipe away the damage done. If I truly forgive someone, that means I have to bear the cost of the damage done. This is costly. Christ had to pay the damage done by our sin, while declaring us "forgiven, righteous and free".
- (2) By this, we are free both from the penalty of sin, and the power of sin.
- (3) Jesus took our place: "The essence of sin is we human beings substituting ourselves for God, while the essence of salvation is God substituting Himself for us. We put ourselves where only God deserves to be; God puts Himself where we deserve to be".
