MARITAL RELATIONSHIP Ephesians 5:22-33

Ephesians 5:22 says "Wives submit to your husband's as to the Lord". The phrase "as to the Lord" is the key to an accurate understanding of what Paul tells the Christian wives to do. In Jesus' time, the women who accompanied Him were devoted to him. Some of them expressed their devotion by lingering at the cross. Some of them came early to the tomb on Easter Day. They brought expensive spices to embalm His body. These women loved the Lord so much that they sacrificed their time, their energy, their emotion, their every being for the sake of his wellbeing. And that is what submission is. Submission is not being held in subjection from terror. It is a positive, deliberate voluntary giving of all that you are and all that you have for the well-being of your husband. Submission is the inward compulsion of love in response to love.

Ephesians 5:25 says "Husbands love your wives just as Christ loved the Church and gave Himself up for her". When Paul instructs Christian husbands to the art of loving their wives, his entire emphasis is on the duty a Christian husband has because of his "headship" to become his wife's self – forgetting companion. The husband is commanded to love his wife – not to rule over her, boss her, control her, command her or enslave her. Therefore, the husband's main aim should be to emulate the love Christ demonstrated for His bride the Church. This kind of love is not just emotion but action to bring about the wife's well-being, happiness and ultimate wholeness, drawing out the full-potential in her. Fulfillment of this duty is the greatest gift a husband can give to his wife. It is liberating. It enables her to recognize her unique being and acknowledge herself worth.

To experience this God-ordained relationship as husband and wife, God must be the centre and authority over all of our lives. Only then, does it become possible for a wife to submit in everything to her husband and for a husband to love his wife. Thus together a home of beauty, strength and character is built for a Godly generation. In order to achieve this, reading the word of God and meditating on it must become our way of life.

Husband and Wife must make deliberate effort to make time to read the word of God together, think together, share together and allow God to speak to them together. Take this time also to share your differences, your failures, your frustrations, disappointments, your plan and vision for the family and commit them to God in prayer. Place before God your ego, the pride that doesn't want to give in, the stubbornness, the anger, the self-centeredness, the negative attitude that sees only the wrong side of everything, hang it all at the cross of Jesus– be broken before God and allow Him to make you whole.

In such atmosphere of worship, it is a privilege and an honour for the wife to submit to her husband and the husband to be loving his wife. This is what God designed marriage to be. It is definitely exciting and make you want to walk the extra mile. God Bless!
