- 8. The necessity of the work of the Holy **Spirit to bring** conviction of sin to the individual sinner, granting him repentance towards God and / faith in Jesus Christ. Thus indwells and works in the believers, sanctifying, instructing and building up the church in their most holy faith.
- 9. The one holy universal church composed **of all** who are united in Christ as God's redeemed community, **visibly** expressed through / the local church.
- 10. The expectation of the second coming of the Lord Jesus Christ.

### WEDNESDAY BIBLE STUDY.

John 16

Christianity is a Trinitarian faith, and therefore our approach to our faith, our prayers, our theology and practise should also be Trinitarian. Church historians tell us that when the church decides to focus on one member of the Trinity and give less important to the others, this church always falls into error. (Some denominations give more importance on the Son-Jesus Christ and some more on the Holy Spirit. To be Trinitarian is to give equal importance and emphasis on all the members of the Trinity).

In this passage, John highlights the work of all the members of the Trinity.

Jesus Christ the Son of God. Jesus said "...fear not, I have overcome the world". What did he mean? Was he not in control all the time? We may ask. There was a time when the Devil had authority over the world to kill, steal and destroy. When he tempted Jesus in Luke 4, he mentioned that authority over the world had "been given to him". We know that the Devil is a lair, but he is smart enough to know that he cannot tell a lie when he is talking to Jesus. I believe he did have some authority over the world, but I don't know how much. But it was as much authority as God had given to Adam and Eve. God gave Adam and Eve to rule over the world, but Satan conned them to give this authority over to him. When Jesus died on the Cross and rose again on the third day, He overcame the world.

This means that our Lord is the Master of this world because he has overcome the world, and the Devil is a defeated enemy. We need not be intimidated by all the temptations, the evil, the fears and depressions that the defeated enemy throws at us. Jesus has overcome. Jesus has overcome the world – so go and live that way!!

<u>God the Father</u>. Jesus said that it is good for us that he is going away, because we cannot have the Spirit unless Jesus goes away. Jesus was glad for us, and we should be too if we understand what he meant.

Jesus is opening up the way for us to get to God and enjoy God as he did while on earth. With the help of the Spirit we can now enjoy the same intimacy that Jesus enjoyed with his Father God while on earth. We can relate to and enjoy God like no one else ever did before. This is the intimacy that even Angels long to look into.

Jesus also promises that when we come to God through him (in his name), God will answer our prayer. We have access to God the creator of all things, the sustainer and giver of all good things.

<u>The Holy Spirit</u>. When the Spirit comes he will convict the world of *sin, righteousness and judgement*. This is also the outline of the Bible which the Holy Spirit wrote – Sin (Fall of Man); Righteousness (giving of the Law); and Judgement (Revelation). This is the primary work of the Holy Spirit – to bring faith in people by causing the New Birth. The world is wrong about sin, righteousness and judgement. The Spirit comes to correct this wrong. Unbelief is sin; righteousness is only of Jesus; God is the judge of all things.

Who defines what sin is? Who defines what is righteous and right? Is it the world through its systems and values, or is it the Holy Spirit through the Word?
