City Church Foundation Day Ist Sunday of July 2018

Bible Passage: 2 Thessalonians 2: 13-17

Context: Apostle Paul warned the believers in the Church of Thessalonica that time of apostasy would come and the man of lawlessness, restrainers would deceive many, turning them to become unbelievers of the true gospel. In the context of the above, Apostle Paul wrote to remind believers to reaffirm the foundation of the gospel and steadfastness to the gospel. The true foundation is Christ Jesus on which the Church is built. (1 Cor 3:11)

In the N.T, Apostles give us reminders again and again e.g. Paul in 2 Thess 2: 15- <u>to</u> <u>stand firm</u> and <u>hold to</u> teachings passed on to Christians. Hebrew author exhorts saying, "Pay much closer attention to what we have heard; so that we do not drift away" (Heb 2:1). Apostle John also reminded his readers saying, "See that what you have heard from the beginning remains in you". (I John 2: 24)

Main Text: (2 Thessalonians 2: 13-17)

Affirmation of Paul: Apostle Paul alludes in this text, the three persons of the Trinity and in particular makes two parallel affirmations:-

Ch. 2: 13: that God chose you to be saved through sanctification by the spirit.

Ch. 2: 14: that God called you through the gospel to share in Christ's glory.

God has chosen us to give us salvation. It is unilateral act of God in choosing us (picked us) through the work of the Holy Spirit to sanctify us ultimately (2: 13), Cf 2 Peter 1: 10. Secondly it is God who called us through the gospel to respond to him and to share in Christ's glory at His coming as partakers of divine nature (2: 14), Cf 2 Peter 1: 3-4.

Paul's Exhortation: Having understood the first two references, Paul exhort Christian to Stand firm and hold to what has been taught.

Paul's Assurance: That God's steadfast purpose for his people is to share the glory of our Lord Jesus. Hence, there is no room for slackness, laziness and complacency.

Paul's Instruction: is to "hold on to" the tradition of apostolic teaching and the truth received must be fully handed on both **by words** or **by letter** as by apostle's example (V-15).

Paul further exhorts in Vv 15-17 addressing brethren (brothers & sisters) to constantly come together as a Church in fellowship, as those needing each other to strengthen and stand together in faith against false teachers, corruption, temptation and persecutions.
