### A Thrill of Walking on Water (Matthew 14:22-33)

Matthew 14 records one of the most hectic day for Jesus. John the Baptist, the forerunner of Jesus was beheaded by Herod. When Jesus got the news at once he withdrew from the crowd by a boat alone into a solitary deserted place - might be to lament, relax emotionally and physically. However, it did not happen for the crowd reached the place already before him. He saw them and was with them the whole day.

After feeding the crowd of thousands out of five bread and two fishes that was brought to him, he sent the crowd away and 'immediately he made the disciples get into the boat... himself to pray (vs22ff)'. The whole night he was in prayer.

A Boat in crises: Meanwhile, a boisterous tempest arose against the boat and it tossed about violently. Disciples were terrified, shaken and exhausted. This was the only time Jesus was not with them. Nevertheless, Jesus knew what was going on with his disciples. Like the disciples, we all have our share of problems and challenges in this world. But in Christ our fears and doubts are dispelled: He said, '...Do not let your heart be troubled and do not be afraid' John. 14:27.

Jesus walks on the water: Early in the morning Jesus was on his way to join them. He went walking on the water. When they saw Jesus they were all the more terrified and cried out, 'It is Ghost'. It is not uncommon to man. Trials and difficulties shaken believers tend to forget the Lord. A hymn writer said "Many things about tomorrow; I don't seem to understand. But I know who holds tomorrow and I know he holds my hand". Amidst their struggle there came a tender voice, Take courage! It is I, Don't be afraid'.'

Peter walks on water: How and why? Except Peter the rest remained quiet. At once Peter shouted back saying, 'Lord ... command me to come to You on the water (NKJV)'. 'Come', Jesus replied. Peter trusted in Jesus' word and immediately stepped out of the boat. He began to walk on water unhindered keeping his eyes fixed on Jesus. Seeing the wind he began to sink. Jesus reached out his hand: hold him by hand and walked together towards the boat. In the whole of eternity none but Peter alone had the thrill of walking on the water with Jesus. Greater thrill still is walking with Jesus hand in hand. The sea calmed down only when they stepped in to the boat. The same Jesus is with us in all our situations. He holds our hand. Nothing can 'separate us from the love of Christ (Rom. 8:35).'

The eleven remained inside the boat. They did not show any excitement as Peter did. They were still unable to get out of the shock. Some may question Peter being rush instead of waiting together with the rest. And yet he did come out of the boat and stepped on the water and walked. Peter knew who Jesus is. He loved to be with Jesus as David said, 'One thing' David 'asked of the Lord' and 'seek' to is to 'dwell in the house of the Lord..., to gaze upon the beauty of the Lord (Psalm 27:4)'.

They could have as well enjoyed the same as Peter which they missed. Today many so called Christians do the same. Let us fix our eyes on Jesus and walk with the Lord: 'Let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and ley us run the race marked out for us. Let us fix our eves on Jesus... (Heb.12:1-2).'
